4. All supporting materials submitted should be clear and legible. These materials become the property of the Oak Bay Secondary School Distinguished Fine Arts Alumni Committee, and will not be returned.

Eligibility

Eligible for a recognition award or election as an honoured member of the Oak Bay Distinguished Fine Arts Alumni is any person, currently alive or deceased, who has achieved an outstanding standard of excellence, in one or more of the following four categories:

<i>Artist</i>	<i>persons whose artistic careers began during their high school education at Oak Bay Secondary School and who have made a contribution to the professional arts community in any of the fine arts disciplines.</i>
<i>Teacher</i>	<i>individuals who have made an outstanding and extraordinary contribution to the school, through their efforts and expertise in the development and training of Oak Bay artists, resulting in the promotion and development of the arts.</i>
<i>Builder</i>	<i>individuals who have made an outstanding and extraordinary contribution in the promotion, development and advancement of fine arts at Oak Bay Secondary School</i>
<i>Patron</i>	<i>individuals, companies or other groups who have made outstanding, significant, long term contributions to fine arts programs at Oak Bay Secondary School through awards, grants, sponsorships or other financial contributions.</i>

Fine Arts, for these purposes include (but are not exclusive to):

<i>Visual arts:</i>	<i>drawing, painting, sculpture, printmaking, calligraphy, photography and film</i>
<i>Music:</i>	<i>composition and performance</i>
<i>Dance:</i>	<i>choreography and performance</i>
<i>Theatre:</i>	<i>acting and directing</i>
<i>Creative Writing:</i>	<i>poetry, playwriting, fiction</i>
